SELBY SCHOLAR PROGRAM

What is it?

- Each year, the Selby Foundation selects 40 local students to receive a renewable scholarship, as well as professional development/networking opportunities.
- Awards vary depending on need. The average award is \$3,500/year, but may be as high as \$7,000/year.
- Selected students must maintain a 3.0 GPA to renew award in subsequent years.

Am I eligible?

- You must be a graduating high school senior and/or an AA/AS degree student from a school in Charlotte, DeSoto, Manatee, or Sarasota County.
- You must have an "Estimated Family Contribution" of \$12,000 or less, as determined by FAFSA.
- You must have at least a 3.0 unweighted GPA.
- You must plan to attend an accredited college or university, with the intention of completing a bachelor's (4-year) degree. Students attending state colleges are eligible.

- Students who are selected as semi-finalists will be invited to interview in late April/early May.
